

POLY TENT SIGN USAGE & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Congratulations on the purchase of your new POLY TENT SIGN from Oakley Signs & Graphics. When properly stored, transported, and displayed, these signs should provide you with several years of use while maintaining a professional appearance.

Protective Bags

Your new Poly Tent Signs are individually wrapped in a clear plastic bag. Not only do these bags provide for added protection during shipping, but they also offer ongoing protection and should be used to cover each of your signs while you transport them from one location to another and during storage. While use of the bags does not guarantee permanent protection, they will reduce the likelihood of damage that may occur from rubbing against other signs or objects. Customers who have followed these guidelines have reported greater overall satisfaction and a longer product life.

Transporting and Storing Signs

Your new Poly Tent Signs are somewhat unique in that they are "handled" and transported more than any other type of sign. As such, the risk of damage is greater and proper care is very important. We recommend transporting and storing the signs in a flat, closed position. Even when transporting and storing the signs inside their plastic bags, care should be taken not to place other items underneath or on top of them as this may cause damage. It is not uncommon for tent signs (once used, or opened) to retain their "muscle memory" and not lie 100% flat. If this occurs, simply place a rubber band around the legs to help hold them in the closed position.

Displaying Signs

One of the unique characteristics of the Poly Tent Sign is its ability to be displayed on almost any ground surface. Due care should be taken to open the tent sign as wide as possible and to place them on an even surface. The more stable the sign is, the more likely that it will stay in an upright and visible position. When placing on softer surfaces like grass, gravel, or dirt, the steel channel legs can be pressed into the surface for additional stability and to help maintain a level stance. Failure to do this may result in the signs blowing or tipping over, resulting in scratching, ink damage, and obstructed readability. Since the Poly Tent Signs are constructed of durable Polyethylene (a plastic), it is common for them to bow. This feature will not affect proper usage or readability.

INSTRUCTION #1 - Prior to transporting or storing signs, place them into their protective plastic bags.

INSTRUCTION #2 – Transport and Store signs in a flat, closed position and with no objects underneath or on top of them. Be sure to keep the signs in their plastic bags.

INSTRUCTION #3 – Display signs in an open, stable position on a flat and level surface. Be sure to wedge legs into stable surface to decrease the likelihood that wind blows them over.
